





1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the time for service of this notice of motion be and is hereby abridged and that the motion is properly returnable today, and further, that any requirement for the service of this notice of motion on any interested parties is hereby dispensed with.
2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Second Report be and the same is hereby accepted and approved.
3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the conduct of the Receiver, its related entities and agents to date, in administering the Estate herein up to and including the date hereof be and it is hereby approved.
4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the fees and disbursements of the Receiver and the fees and disbursements of the Receiver's legal counsel, as more particularly described in the Second Report, be and they are hereby approved, assessed and allowed as filed.
5. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Receiver is directed and authorized to:  
(a) notify, in writing sent by courier and registered mail (the "**Tooling Notice**"), all known parties with tooling in the premises of Bruin located at 16567 Highway 12, Midland, Ontario (the "**Premises**"), that such tooling is to be removed from the Premises within 30 days, failing which the tooling will be destroyed and sold as scrap metal; and (b) destroy all tooling remaining at the premises of Bruin, forty (40) days after sending the Tooling Notice, and sell same as scrap metal.
6. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the distributions to the National Bank of Canada ("**National Bank**"), the Bank of Nova Scotia ("**BNS**") and North Simcoe Community Futures Development Corporation ("**North Simcoe**") as set out in the Second Report, are hereby approved and ratified.
8. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the costs of the Receiver in the preparation of this motion and of these proceedings up to and including the hearing of this motion and the entrance of this order (including applicable goods and

services) shall be paid to the Receiver from this date herein in accordance with the Appointment Order.
